Migration continues to shape European societies—but it also raises real challenges. Negative public attitudes toward migration often stem from concerns about security, jobs, cultural identity, and the effectiveness of current migration policies. People may feel that governments and the EU are not doing enough to manage migration, or that immigrants pose a threat to local resources and values. These concerns are often amplified by political rhetoric and media portrayals.

To move beyond fear and misinformation, we need informed, open conversations.

At this event, five leading academic experts from Italy, Croatia, Spain, Poland, and Austria will share their insights on national experiences and integration strategies. Together, we will discuss how to create more effective, fair, and trusted policies to support migrants entering the European workforce.
